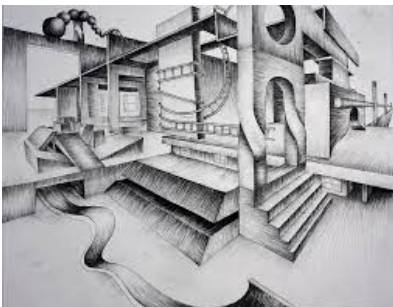
In Art 1 (K-2nd) your student will begin to learn about some of the basic principles of art. One of our areas of focus will be the color wheel and how to mix colors as we use mediums like oil pastels and water color paints. They will have fun getting their hands dirty with clay as they begin to see the difference between 2D and 3D art. It will be an exciting year of creativity as they explore their artistic side.



In Art 2 (3rd-5th) your student will start to learn to see things as an artist would. Then they will learn how to transfer what they see to their artwork. They will be working with charcoal as they learn about form and values in art. We will also explore mediums such as oil pastels, water color paint and chalk. It's sure to be a fun year of discovery as their creativity continues to develop.



In Art 3 (6th-8th) we will begin to really focus on the six main elements of art. We will work on pencil skills, learn charcoal techniques, work with chalk pastels, learn about perspective, work with clay, and begin learning the basic elements of painting. No matter your student's skill level, there will be something for everyone in this class.



In Art 4 (9th-12th) your student will begin to master the six main elements of art and begin to learn about what makes up good composition. They will stretch their abilities as we master pencil drawing, and dig deep into charcoal and chalk pastels. We will also be painting in ink, water color, and acrylic paints. We will explore new mediums like plaster and quilling. It will be a year of exploration and development as your student finds the artist within.

Art 1-3 are 1 hour per week for 32 weeks. The cost is \$300 per year and is due before the first day of class. Payment arrangements can be made if needed. There is also a \$60 supply fee that is due by July 31st. This will hold your child's spot and will be non-refundable after this date.

Art 4 will be 1.5 hour per week for 32 weeks. The cost is \$350 per year and is due before the first day of class. Payment arrangements can be made if needed. There is also a \$75 supply fee that is due by July 31st. This will hold your child's spot and will be non-refundable after this date.
